



## Summer Internship

Date: 1 June 2007 to 15 August 2007

Location: Glasgow, Scotland

For Whom: Ideally suited for seminary students or others training to become leaders in a church. Interns would want to grow in their passion for Christ through the Bible, love for the Church, and understanding of ministering in a cross-cultural context.

What: Re:Hope Next Generation Church is a new church (circa 2005) in Glasgow's West End with a congregation size of 70+. Our ministry philosophy is founded on the concepts of Commune, Community, and Mission. We desire to bring people who are far from God around people who are near to God by developing a people passionate to share this kingdom life. We desire to be unashamedly Biblical and uncompromisingly missional.

Course *The intern will:*

- Objectives:
- Learn and live the Commune, Community, Mission ethos
  - Pursue a declared area of interest/passion in which to serve
  - Participate in our staff community rhythm of Bible reading, prayer, planning, and fun
  - Serve the last, least, and lost at the Glasgow City Mission

Costs: \$3000 (50% due by May 10, 90% by 1 June)

This budget covers housing (potentially living with a non-believer), utilities, council tax, food, ministry expenses and miscellaneous. It does not cover airfare to Glasgow or personal expenses above the basics.

A U.S. Passport is required. This costs \$97 (\$157 expedited) if you don't already have one. This process can take 6 weeks.

Church Resource Ministries (CRM), of which Re:Hope is a part, will set up an account into which your donors may give. There is no assessment (CRM admin fee) for interns.
