Over the last few years we have processed online giving to Re:Hope via the Dove Trust. This was primarily because it was a convenient “all-in-one” package that also processed gift aid at the same time.

Over the last year or so there have, unfortunately, been some problems with this system, especially with those who have set up the Dove Trust to take regular, monthly donations on behalf of Re:Hope.

In light of this we have decided to change the way that we receive offerings for both regular and online givers. If you would like to set up a regular, monthly offering via a standing order into the Re:Hope bank account, please speak to Stephen Iriwn (stephen@rehope.co.uk) who will give you the appropriate forms to fill in, including the gift aid form if you are a UK taxpayer.

If you would like to give one-off donations or if you would like to give your monthly donations one-at-a-time online, we are now taking these payments via **PayPal**. If you are a UK taxpayer we will still need you to fill in a **gift aid** form so that we can claim back the tax you have already paid from the government (this form can be downloaded from the online giving page at www.rehope.co.uk). You do not need a PayPal account in order to give, as paypal can process one-off credit/debit card transactions. Just click on the donate button and follow the instructions under the section titled “Don’t have a PayPal account?”
